Kindly be advised that the Cape Town Container Terminal have, in the interests of additional safety, taken a precautionary decision to close the Cape Town Container Terminal on the day shift today, 10 May 2020, from 06.00 to 18.00. This is to enable additional deep cleaning of all facilities and equipment in light of the sudden increase in pandemic cases in the Western Cape

Please again be assured that TPT has in place the best practice measures to safeguard the wellbeing of all our employees and parties conducting business in the Terminal. These practices are in line with the Government Regulations and include the sanitization by means of "fogging" of facilities and equipment, stringent application of the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as well as adhering to mandatory hygiene management protocols.

This decision to close for a twelve hour shift was not easy, but these additional measures were deemed necessary and will go a long way in supporting the safety of our employees and our Terminal users. Our sincere apologies for the late decision and communication in this regard.
