RE: AUDIT ON THE APPLICATION OF THE FALSE CODLING MOTH MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (FMS) ON CITRUS INTENDED FOR EXPORT TO THE EUROPEAN UNION

The National plant Protection Organization of South Africa (NPPOZA) will commence with audits on the various control points of the citrus FMS e.g. production units, pack houses, cold storage/ loading facilities and the Perishable Products Export Control Board (PPECB).
