2021 CITRUS TREE CENSUS: CAPTURING YOUNG ORCHARDS

Following the earlier call to citrus growers last week, CGA are reminding growers to send in the Tree Census details for new orchards – the orchards that were NOT captured on the PhytClean system in Nov/Dec 2021. This information is aggregated to provide an understanding of future citrus volumes, which is critical for infrastructure optimization and planning and address challenges like logistics issues).
